Sankt Stefan ob Leoben is located in the southeast of Austria and in the geographical center of Styria.

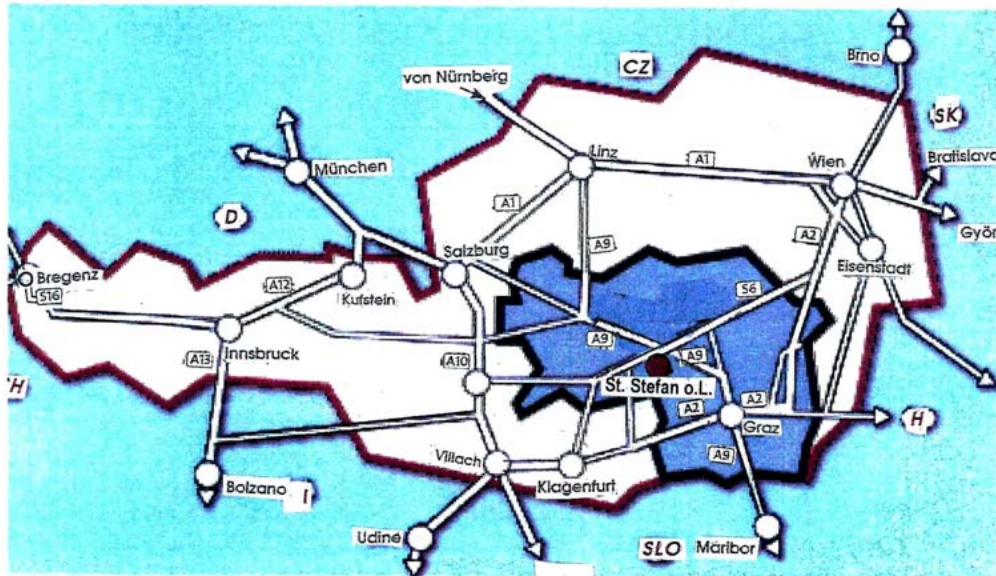

4 – Starting order: - in accordance to the draw by FITE in November 2009 at Verona

5 – Judges:

International FITE judges are mandatory for this event. Half (16) of the 32 judges, which are required for the PTV, are foreign judges. Each national organization will announce 2 to 4 judges and the Organizing Committee will select 16 out of these in a balanced relationship.

Accommodation and meals will be paid by the OC from Friday 3rd until Sunday 5th September 2010.

Accommodation: Hotel Gietl at Kammern (approx. 8 km from showground, shuttle service will be provided).

Travel costs are not covered by the Organizing Committee.

Important: no reimbursement of costs if a different accommodation is chosen

6 – Rules and special (participation) conditions:

This Championship will be held under international TREC rules by FITE (conditions 1.1.2010). By submitting their entries all federations and participants accept the TREC rules of FITE and the national regulation for shows in Austria (ÖTO).

Please note the amendment for young riders within the TREC rules, which have been adopted in December 2007 during the FITE bureau meeting.

The participation is on own risk of the riders. He OC will NOT be responsible for any damage caused by athletes, their horses, officials, their employees/grooms or their representatives.

The veterinary inspection is no warranty for the health of the horses.

INVITATION European Championship open:

- Seniors: each nation may send a team of max. 6 qualified riders **minimum age 16 years at first day of competition**; the organizing NF can enter additional six individual riders.
- Young riders: each nation may send a team of max. 6 qualified riders **minimum age 16 years (at first day of competition)** up to 21 years (in the year of the event); the organizing NF can enter additional six individual riders.
- Horses: Minimum age 6 years, at least 1,30 m hands high

7 – Insurances:

All Chefs d'Equipe, athletes, owners, trainers, team veterinarians and their accompaniments are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees/grooms, their agents or their horses.

Each rider must have a sufficient insurance protection.

The insurance protection must cover also participation in competitions abroad.

8 – Horse passports:

FEI passports are not compulsory for the participation of the horses. The horses need a valid national passport for their definite identification.

Following details must be listed in the national passport:

- Horse diagram
- Person responsible/owner
- Record of Vaccination against Equine Influenza (please see Art. 9)

Even if in the country of origin of the horses no national regulation exists for vaccination against equine influenza, all horses must have a valid vaccination certificate.

9 – Vaccination against Equine Influenza:

in accordance with the FEI Veterinary Regulations, appendix VI (current version 2009): in the FEI passport or in the national passport, which is issued for all horses and Ponies, the two initial influenza vaccinations must be dated and signed by a vet, who is not the owner of the horse. The period between the two initial vaccinations must be at least 21 days and not exceeding 92 days.

The booster vaccination must be within 6 month/+21 days after the date of administration of the second primary dose, with at least annual boosters given subsequently (i.e. within one year of the last dose). No vaccination shall be given within 7 days of the day of arrival at the event.

The initial vaccination and booster vaccinations should be administered according to the manufacturer's instructions (i.e. intramuscular injection or intranasal).

10 – Health Certificate:

At the time of first examination, i.e. upon arrival of the horses on the show grounds and before entering the stables, every athlete is required to have on hand the health certificates and supporting documents required for the transport to the event and admittance to the stabling area.

- a) Horses from a EU member state, a health certificate according to appendix B of the guideline 90/426 is required (in the valid version);
- b) Horses from a non-EU member state, a health certificate according to appendix II consignment 92/260 is required (in the valid version);

The certificate must be issued in at least one official language of the country of destination and in one official language of the member country. The athlete must carry with him the original certificate, not a copy!

The organizer sees to it that on the competition site an accredited veterinarian is present to issue health certificates which are necessary for the transport of the horses to their destination abroad.

All inquiries regarding Health Certificates can be addressed to the authorities in the country of residence or to the veterinary office where the event takes place.



11 – Horse inspection /equipment control:

Each rider must present his horse as well as the accompanying documents on Friday 3rd, September 2010, according to the time table between 8 – 12 a.m., within the zone therefore reserved; equipment control will be affected afterwards.

12 – Medication control:

This Championship is organized in accordance with the valid FEI Medication Control and Anti-Doping Rules, and the Austrian regulations of the Anti-Doping Federal law in the current version (BGBl.I 146/2009).

Code of Conduct:

The FITE expects all those involved in equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their area of expertise.
